Report of the Head of Legal and Democratic Services

1. **LICENSING ACT 2003 – LICENSING ACT 2003 (HEARINGS)
REGULATION 2005 – APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES
LICENCE – THE DILLWYN, 1 HERBERT STREET,
PONTARDAWE**

The Sub Committee was asked to consider an application for a Premises Licence for the above mentioned premises. The circulated report contained details of the application under the Licensing Act 2003.

The Licensing Manager updated the Sub Committee on the background of the premises as detailed in the circulated report. Members noted that the application was for a new premises licence as the previous licence had been surrendered on the 18th August, 2008.

Representations had been made by the Police and Environmental Health Section, as contained in Appendix 1 of the circulated report. Members noted the request for additional conditions to be added to the Premises Licence. The Applicant had agreed to these conditions and as a result the Police and Environmental Health Section had withdrawn their representations.

The Sub Committee then adjourned prior to reaching its final decision.

RESOLVED: that the above application be granted, subject to the conditions consistent with the premises operating schedule and the additional conditions agreed by the Police and the Environmental Health Section as set out below:-

- (i) that a digital CCTV system approved by South Wales Police be installed at the premises and be operational at all times during opening hours and that the tapes are to be kept for a period of 28 days and be available to the Police and Licensing Authority on demand;
- (ii) that entertainment noise should be inaudible inside any noise sensitive property;
- (iii) that the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) must be a participating member of the Pontardawe Pub Watch Scheme.
