Report of the Licensing Manager

1. <u>LICENSING ACT 2003 – APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES</u> <u>LICENCE – THE ROYAL QUEEN HOTEL, QUEENS ROAD,</u> <u>SKEWEN, NEATH</u>

The Sub Committee was asked to consider the application for a premises licence for the above mentioned premises. The circulated report contained details of the application under the Licensing Act 2003. A plan of the above mentioned premises was tabled at the meeting.
