- 1. The premises will employ six SIA licensed door staff. If the first floor of the premises is used a further two must be used. A log must be kept of the duty state of the door staff. This log must be kept available for inspection by the Police and the Local Authority Licensing Department.
- 2. Two of the staff on duty must position themselves at the exit point onto Queen Street Back Lane to facilitate and supervise the safe exit of customers.
- 3. CCTV tapes must be kept for a period of 28 days as a condition of the licence, and access permitted to the Police and the Local Authority staff.
- 4. CCTV system will be agreed by the Police Crime Prevention Officer in respect of coverage and quality of system.
- 5. Only polycarbonate vessels will be used. No bottles and other vessels may be permitted to be removed from the premises.
- 6. Doors and windows will be closed whenever regulated entertainment is provided.
- 7. The only acceptable means of proving age will be by means of photographic driving licence or passport.

- 8. The audible sound level within the premises shall not exceed the decibel level set by the Local Environmental Authority (96 decibels).
- 9. No amplified music to be played on second floor of premises.
- 10. The sound system to be checked and assessed by an appropriate member of staff and to be in compliance of 96db; all entries to be logged.
- 11. An extra set of double doors in place in front of main entrance to now create a lobby area before access to premises, this shall reduce noise pollution to the general public.
- 12. The amplification system in place is not and shall not be accessible to the DJ to allow him/her to increase the audible level of sound at any time. The sound system to be checked by an appropriate member and logged.
- 13. Entertainment noise must be inaudible at any residential property.
