## **Report of the Head of Legal Services**

### **1. LICENSING ACT (2003) – TRANSITIONAL PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATIONS – THE DUKE OF WELLINGTON, 8 OLD MARKET STREET, NEATH, WEST GLAMORGAN**

The Sub Committee was asked to consider the licence applications for both conversion and variation of the Transitional Premises Licence for the above mentioned premises.

#### **(a) Conversion Application**

The Sub Committee was informed that, as the premises was currently trading as a public house, the applicant would be entitled to a premises licence for the sale of alcohol with the previous permitted hours becoming conditions of the new licence.
