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### **Report of the Head of Legal and Democratic Services**

1. **APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE –  
JIMMY'S BAR, 33 STATION ROAD, PORT TALBOT, SA13 1NN**

The Sub Committee was asked to consider the application of a Premises Licence for the above-mentioned premises. The circulated report contained details of the application made under the Licensing Act 2003.

The Applicants attended the meeting represented by Counsel Mr. C. Jones and their Solicitor, Mr. J. Hussell.

### **Amended Conditions**

1. A minimum of one Personal Licence Holder is to be present on the premises whilst it is open to the public.
2. No children permitted on the ground floor after 21.00. In private functions on the first floor all children must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
3. No entry/re-entry into the premises one hour before the end of licensable activities.
4. The Premises Licence Holder shall participate in the Neath Port Talbot Business Crime Reduction Partnership (BCRP), Pub Watch and Nite Net radio schemes and the Premises Licence Holder or a suitable representative shall attend at all meetings.
5. The Challenge 21 Proof of Age policy or similar scheme as approved by the Police shall be operated at all times whilst the premises are open to the public.
6. A digital CCTV system is to be implemented in conjunction with the Police which provides coverage for all public areas and exits (both internal and external). Images must be retained for a minimum of 31 days. Staff are to be properly trained in its use and the system must in operation at all times whilst the premises are open to the public.
7. All reasonable precautions must be taken to minimise entertainment noise leakage from the premises. All windows and doors are to be kept closed when amplified entertainment is taking place.
8. An anti drug policy is to be implemented in agreement with the Police and operated at all times whilst the premises is open to the public. A Drugs Drop Safe is to be installed in accordance with Police requirements and provision made for searches and drug testing procedures in conjunction with the Police.
9. The premises will operate a daily register of security personnel in accordance with the requirements of the Police. The register must be available for inspection by the Police and Authorised Officers of the Licensing Authority. The register must be retained for a period of three years.

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11. A counting system is to be implemented to monitor the number of customers entering the premises, to ensure maximum numbers are not exceeded.
12. Whenever regulated entertainment is provided a minimum of two doors supervisors must be provided at the premises. When both the ground floor and first floor of the premises are in use there shall be a minimum of four door supervisors.
13. Polycarbonate glasses must be used when the premises is open to the public on Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays and in addition on any other day if the premises is screening a major sporting event or any other event designated by the police.
14. No drinks promotions are to be provided except between 19.00 and 23.00 when the minimum cost will be £1.50 per standard drink.
15. Customers shall from time to time be subject to searches by appropriate security personnel as a condition of entering the premises.
16. Slower and quieter music shall be played for the last 30 minutes of licensable activities.
17. No customers are to be allowed to consume alcohol or other beverages outside the front entrance of the premises.
18. No customers are to enter or exit the premises other than via the front entrance on Station Road. The rear doors are for emergency use only.
