Report of the Head of Legal Services

1. **LICENSING (2003) ACT TRANSITIONAL PREMISES LICENCE
APPLICATIONS – GWYN ARMS, GWYNS PLACE, ALLTWEN,
PONTARDAWE, SWANSEA**

The Sub Committee was asked to consider the undermentioned licence applications for both Conversion and Variation of a Transitional Premises Licence for the above mentioned premises. The applicant Punch Taverns Plc attended the meeting in support of the application.

(a) Conversion Application

The Sub Committee was informed that, as the premises had traded as a Public House for many years, the applicant would be entitled to a premises licence for the sale of alcohol, with the previous permitted hours becoming conditions of the new licence.

(b) Variation Application

The circulated report contained details of the application for the variation of a premises licence during the transitional period under Schedule 8 of the Licensing (2003) Act.

In accordance with the prescribed procedure the Sub Committee heard representations from the applicant and questioned all parties concerned. The circulated report contained details of information provided by the applicant relating to the promotion of the four licensing objectives.

The circulated report also contained details of written representations received from the responsible Authorities. Personal representations were also made by the Environmental Health Officer and Police. The Sub Committee adjourned following receipt of all representation prior to reaching the final decision.
