## Report of the Head of Legal Services

## 1. <u>LICENSING ACT 2003 - PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATION – MR. P. O'DWYER, 23 SITWELL WAY, PORT TALBOT</u>

The Sub Committee was asked to consider the licence application for the above mentioned premises. The applicant, Mr. Paul O'Dwyer, attended the hearing in support of the application. The circulated report contained details of the application for the premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 in accordance with the prescribed procedure.

The Sub Committee heard representations from the applicant and questioned all parties concerned. The circulated report contained details of information provided by the applicant relating to the promotion of the four licensing objectives. The circulated report also contained details of written representations received from the Poilice.

Representations were made at the hearing by the Police Authority. The Sub Committee adjourned following receipt of all representations prior to reaching the final decision.

**RESOLVED:** that the application be refused for the following reasons:-

- (a) the premises were unsuitable for such a venture and it would be contrary to the prevention of public nuisance licensing objective;
- (b) the Sub Committee were not satisfied that the venture would meet the licensing objectives of prevention of children from harm and prevention of crime and disorder.
