### **Report of the Head of Legal Services**

1. **LICENSING (2003) ACT TRANSITIONAL PREMISES LICENCE  
APPLICATIONS – ROYAL EXCHANGE INN, 107 BRITON  
FERRY ROAD, NEATH**

The Sub Committee was asked to consider the under mentioned licence applications for a Variation of a Transitional Premises Licence for the above mentioned premises. The applicant Mrs. Deborah Walters attended the meeting in support of the application.

(a) **Variation Application**
