# 1. <u>LICENSING ACT 2003 – TRANSITIONAL PREMISES LICENCE</u> <u>APPLICATIONS – TYN Y TWR TAVERN, TYN Y TWR ROAD,</u> <u>BAGLAN, PORT TALBOT, WEST GLAMORGAN</u>
