1. <u>LICENSING ACT 2003 (HEARINGS) REGULATION 2005 –</u> <u>APPLICATION TO VARY A PREMISES LICENCE – OXYGEN,</u> 44-46 STATION ROAD, PORT TALBOT

The Sub Committee was asked to consider varying a Premises Licence. The circulated report contained details of the application under the Licensing Act 2003.
