1. **LICENSING (2003) ACT**
TRANSITIONAL PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATIONS –
COLLIERS ARMS, SKEWEN, NEATH

The Sub Committee was asked to consider the undermentioned licence applications for both conversion and variation of a Transitional Premises Licence for the Colliers Arms, Skewen, Neath.

The applicant, Mr. Cant, attended the meeting in support of the applications.

The Sub Committee was informed that as the premises had traded as a Public House for many years the applicant would be entitled to a Premises Licence for the sale of alcohol with the previous permitted hours becoming conditions of the new licence.
