Report of the Licensing Manager

1. **APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE –
DOHERTY'S, 12 HIGH STREET, GLYNNEATH, NEATH**

The Sub Committee was asked to consider the application for a variation of a Premises Licence for the above mentioned premises. The circulated report contained details of the application made under the Licensing Act 2003.

The applicant attended the Sub Committee along with his two brothers.

In accordance with the prescribed procedure, the Sub Committee heard representations from all parties present.

The Sub Committee then adjourned, following receipt of all representations, prior to reaching its final decision.

RESOLVED: that the application be granted subject to the condition outlined below:-

“(1) No live music to be played on the ground floor of the premises until acoustic works have been undertaken to the satisfaction of the Environmental Health Department so as to ensure that the live music shall be inaudible inside any noise sensitive property”.

2. **APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF A PREMISES LICENCE – KITTY’S, 6 JAMES STREET, PONTARDAWE**

The Sub Committee was asked to consider the application for a variation of a Premises Licence for Kitty’s Public House. The circulated report contained details of the application made under the Licensing Act 2003.

The applicant, Mr.P.Rees, attended the meeting along with his daughter.

In accordance with the prescribed procedure, the Sub Committee heard representations from the Applicant and the Police Authority and also took into account the representations of four residents which were contained in the circulated report. The Sub Committee adjourned following receipt of all representations prior to reaching its final decision.

RESOLVED: that the application be granted.

3. **APPLICATION FOR A GAMING MACHINE PERMIT – JIMMY’S BAR, 33 STATION ROAD, PORT TALBOT**

The Licensing Manager advised Members that Premises that are authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on the premises have an automatic right to provide two or less gaming machines and the application was for an additional two machines on the first floor of the establishment.
