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### Report of the Head of Legal Services

# 1. <u>LICENSING 2003 ACT – LICENCE APPLICATION – BRITON FERRY AFC, OLD ROAD, BRITON FERRY, NEATH</u>

The Sub Committee was asked to consider the license application for a premises license for the above mentioned premises. The applicant's representative, Mr. Ken Duggan, attended the hearing in support of the application.

The Fire Officer, Ceri Roberts, addressed the Committee in relation to representations which were submitted as an Appendix to the circulated report.

The Committee was informed that although some matters addressed in the representations from the Fire Authority had been resolved, certain items on the Schedule of Works had yet to be carried out.

# 2. <u>LICENSING 2003 ACT – PREMISES LICENCE APPEAL TO MAGISTRATES COURT – MINERS ARMS, OLD ROAD, SKEWEN, NEATH</u>

The Committee was informed that the above mentioned premises were granted a premises license by this Committee on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2006 subject to conditions regarding the ground floor and first floor capacity. The conditions were imposed after representations from the Police and Fire Officer regarding an agreement which had been reached with the Applicant.

The Committee was told that the applicant had appealed to the Magistrates Court regarding the capacity levels set by the Committee as they claimed they were not as agreed.

The Committee was informed that the Fire Officer and the Applicant had reached agreement that the ground floor capacity be altered from 50 persons to 80 persons and the first floor capacity to remain at 50 persons.

**RESOLVED:** That the Premises Licence be amended to include the following condition:-

the capacity level of the premises be:-

- (a) Ground floor 80 persons;
- (b) First floor 50 persons.
