## **Report of the Head of Legal Services**

1. <u>LICENSING (2003) ACT - TRANSITIONAL PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATIONS – MERLINS ALBERT INN, 91 – 93 WINDSOR</u> ROAD, NEATH
