1. **LICENSING ACT 2003 – APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES
LICENCE – TAKEAWAY PREMISES, 51 STATION ROAD,
PORT TALBOT, SA13 1NW**

The Sub Committee was asked to consider an application for a Premises Licence for the above mentioned premises. The circulated report contained details of the application under the Licensing Act 2003.

The applicant attended the meeting and advised members in respect of his application. He also requested that the opening time be amended to noon rather than 7.00am.

The Licensing Manager gave Members an overview of the application as well as circulating a location plan and photograph of the premises at the start of the meeting.

Members noted that there had been no representations from responsible authorities; however, one interested party had made a written representation, as detailed in the circulated report. The interested party was not present at the meeting.

The Licensing Manager explained to the Sub Committee that the licence was for late night refreshment, and would not cover the sale of alcohol or the provision of entertainment.
