Report of the Head of Legal Services

1. <u>LICENSING ACT 2003 (HEARINGS) REGULATION 2005 – APPLICATION FOR A PREMISES LICENCE – DOVE WORKSHOP, ROMAN ROAD, BANWEN, NEATH, SA10 9LW</u>

The Sub Committee was asked to consider an application for a Premises Licence for the above mentioned premises. The circulated report contained details of the application under the Licensing Act 2003.

The applicant and her representative attended the meeting.

The Licensing Officer gave Members an overview of the circulated report, and a location plan and a floor plan of the premises were also circulated to all present at the meeting.

Members noted that two representations had been received in respect of the application, one from an Interested Party living near the premises (the Interested Party did not attend the hearing and the Committee decided to proceed in his absence), and one from the Police. The Police representation was subsequently withdrawn, subject to the following conditions being applied to any licence granted:

- (a) Where drinks are to be consumed in the area marked "landscaped area" on the attached plan, only plastic or polycarbonate drinking vessels shall be used.
- (b) An incident recording book shall be maintained at the premises showing details of the date and time of all assaults, injuries, accidents or ejections, as well as details of the members of staff involved, the nature of the incident and the action/outcome. The book must be kept available for inspection by the Police and authorised officers of the Local Authority.

After considering all representations, the Sub Committee adjourned to make its decision.

RESOLVED: that the application, as detailed in the circulated

report, be approved, subject to the addition of the two

conditions as outlined above.
