## **Report of the Head of Legal Services**

1. **LICENSING (2003) ACT – TRANSITIONAL PREMISES**  
**LICENCE APPLICATIONS – PONTARDAWE RUGBY CLUB,**  
**YNYSDERW ROAD, PONTARDAWE, SWANSEA**

The Sub Committee was asked to consider the licence applications for both conversion and variation of a Transitional Premises Licence for the above mentioned premises.

The applicant, Mr.A.G.Morgan, who was treasurer of Pontardawe Rugby Club attended the meeting in support of the application. Also present were persons who had submitted objections to the variation application.
