SICKNESS ABSENCE MANAGEMENT

Purpose of Report

To report the latest sickness absence data for the services within the Committee's portfolio and to provide an update on the progress of the Corporate review of sickness absence management.

Progress Update

A new approach to sickness absence management has been developed and trialled. The review is now moving into an implementation phase with the aim of having the new approach fully embedded across the Council by the end of March.

The phasing for rolling out the new approach is as follows:

Social Services Health and Housing	December 2010
Finance and Corporate Services	January 2011
Education Leisure and Lifelong	March 2011

An Implementation Board has been set up to oversee the work and to monitor the effect of the new approach. A key role for the Board will be to identify further opportunities for improvement that can be pursued beyond this current project.

An initial meeting has been held with school governors and it is anticipated that work with schools will commence early in the New Year. An implementation plan will be drawn up with schools to trial and roll out a revised approach that is suitable for school settings.

In terms of overall levels of sickness absence, the tables attached show that sickness absence rates appear to be falling. While the new approach to absence management has yet to be rolled out, since March 2010 a significant profile has been given to reducing levels of absenteeism across the whole Council. Clearly, the position will need to be monitored closely to ensure that performance improvement is sustainable.

It is intended that management information will considerably enhanced once the new approach is implemented. In the meantime, the available data is presented to assist Members in their scrutiny role.

That the progress on the corporate review be noted and that the data is received and reviewed by the Committee.
