#### PART 1 SECTION A – MATTERS FOR DECISION

#### ITEM 1

#### DISCRETIONARY RATE RELIEF SCHEME

#### 1. Purpose of Report

To recommend that the criteria for granting discretionary rate relief be amended to cover the granting of 20% top up discretionary relief to WRVS shops on hospital premises.

## 2. Background

Charity shops are entitled to 80% mandatory rate relief, but the current criteria for discretionary rate relief provide that no top up relief is granted.

We have now received re-applications for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2011 to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2014 from the WRVS in respect of 4 shops which they operate at the Neath Port Talbot Hospital in Baglan.

Previously you have agreed to grant the 20% top up discretionary relief to the WRVS, but this is not reflected in the wording of the scheme of discretionary rate relief adopted earlier this year.

## 3. Financial Implications

The annual cost of granting the top up discretionary relief to the 4 WRVS shops is £2,750, which can be accommodated within the Authority's budget for discretionary rate relief.

#### 4. Recommendation

To amend the criteria for granting discretionary rate relief to cover the granting of 20% top up discretionary relief to WRVS shops on hospital premises

### 5. Reason for Proposed Decision

To bring the approved scheme of discretionary rate relief into line with previous decisions on granting relief.
