#### MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS APPLICATIONS

## **Existing Policy Statement**

- 1.1 a) Each application will be considered on its merits.
  - b) The Committee will only approve applications for financial assistance from voluntary or charitable organisations which are manifestly committed to voluntary endeavours of a local nature. This will not preclude the consideration of applications where the disposal of funds is outside the area but still provides significant benefits for the people from the Neath Port Talbot area.
  - c) No applications will be considered from religious bodies except relating to church halls and other premises where there is significant community use of the property for non-religious activities.
  - d) No applications will be considered from other public funded bodies such as community councils, hospital trusts, etc. or where the benefit may be in lieu of their contributions such as appeals for hospital equipment.
  - e) Applications from individuals may be considered where both the person and the community derive a benefit.
  - f) No grants will be made to any individual or organisation whose prime purpose is to distribute their funds to other charitable bodies.

# 1.3 Neath Port Talbot Disability Network Action Group

From 1996 to 2009 the Neath Port Talbot Access Group received an annual grant from the Council to cover their core costs. In 2009 they received a grant of £2102. Due to their inability to recruit new members the group disbanded.

A new group, the Neath Port Talbot Disability Network Action Group has recently been set up with the objectives of "to improve the equality, status, independence, mobility and wellbeing for people of all ages and abilities, with particular emphasis on disability".

This group has applied for core funding of "about £1500".

I have written to the group to obtain copies of their constitution, budget for the year and their current membership.

As the next meeting of the Policy & Resources Board will not be until June it is recommended that delegated powers be granted to the Director of Finance and Corporate Services in consultation with the Leader, Deputy Leader and Chair of the Scrutiny Committee to determine the application for 2012/13 only with a review to take place for 2013/14.
