# <u>AUTHORISATION FOR A LEGAL OFFICER TO APPEAR IN THE MAGISTRATES' AND COUNTY COURTS</u>

#### 1. Purpose of Report

1.1. To obtain authorisation for a legal officer to appear in the Magistrates' Court.

#### 2. **Background**

- 2.1. The Authority's trainee solicitor Laura Williams who is currently with the Joint Child Care Team, has asked if she could represent the Authority in the Magistrates' Court in one of the cases she has been dealing with. The case is a Neath Port Talbot child care case and was listed for the 26<sup>th</sup> August 2010. The Senior Child Care Lawyer agreed that this is a suitable case for Laura Williams to conduct before the Magistrates and would be good experience for her.
- 2.2. The bulk of legal officers who appear in the Courts on behalf of the Authority have right of audience in that they are either Solicitors or Barristers.
- 2.3. In order to make best use of staff time and in order to provide training opportunities to more junior staff the authority has had a general practice of granting statutory authorisations to legal executives and other "paralegals" to undertake suitable court work on your behalf. In respect of trainee solicitors it also gives them excellent experience of appearing in Court which they would not obtain if they had a training contract in private practice.
- 2.4. Under Section 223 (1) of the Local Government Act 1972 it is possible for a local authority to authorise an officer to appear on its behalf in the Magistrates' Court.

#### 3. **Decision**

#### 3.1. That Laura Williams:-

(a) be authorised to represent Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council in the Magistrates' Court pursuant to section 223 (1) of the Local Government Act 1972 in Child Care proceedings [a copy of the Urgency Action is attached to this report].

#### 4. Reason for proposed decision

4.1. To enable the named officer to represent the authority in the Magistrates' Court.
