## SICKNESS ABSENCE MANAGEMENT INFORMATION – CORPORATE REVIEW

#### **Purpose of Report**

To provide Members with employee sickness absence management information for April 2010 and to update Members on the progress of the Corporate Sickness Review.

### **Background**

The Council is facing a period of unprecedented change. To support the changes, Cabinet has approved a Workforce Strategy which, amongst other things, seeks to reduce the levels of absence (and associated costs) due to sickness.

Policy and Resources Scrutiny Committee received a short presentation on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2010 on the approach to be taken to the review. The Committee has already asked for additional information to be provided on the levels of absence across the Council and for similar data to be made available to all scrutiny committees. The data enclosed shows the number of incidences of long term sickness absence (more than 28 days) and the number of working days lost due to sickness absence that relates. Data is also enclosed showing employees who have had three or more occasions of sickness absence in the last 12 months and the working days lost these absences relate to. It is intended that this information will be presented to Scrutiny Committees on a quarterly basis. Additionally, Policy and Resources Committee will receive information demonstrating how absence patterns and levels are changing over time.

In terms of the Review itself, the following actions have been taken since 1<sup>st</sup> April 2010:-

- Heads of Service have been provided with data identifying cases which warrant detailed scrutiny;
- Heads of Service have provided the Chief Executive with assurances that sickness absence is receiving active management attention;
- Trade Unions have actively engaged in the review;
- The review team have interviewed a wide range of employees about absence levels and the current policy approach;

- The need to emphasise the importance of regular attendance and also to ensure that return to work interviews establish the underlying cause of any absence are areas for early attention. This conclusion is based on the views of the employees who have been interviewed by the review team members;
- In addition to the areas highlighted in the point above, management information, the need to simplify procedures, amend the current policy and the need to clarify the roles of managers/occupational health unit/employees and personnel officers have been cited as areas that need to be addressed;
- Work to develop more meaningful measure to gauge progress in tackling sickness absence management has commenced;
- A set of principles against which the changes need to be assessed have been drawn up;
- The Streetcare Service has volunteered to trial a new approach to absence management and trials commenced three weeks ago. It is intended that all areas with relatively high absence levels will be subject of detailed review through a task & finish approach carried out jointly between management and trade unions;
- There is active involvement of those accountable managers with the highest sickness absence level in the review team;
- 'Best Practice' research has been carried out;
- The scrutiny of sickness absence for each committee has been scheduled at quarterly intervals.

#### Recommended

- 1) Members note the update provided and endorse the approach being taken by the review team.
- 2) Members consider inviting Heads of Service whose services fall within this committee's portfolio to attend a future meeting to discuss the underlying reasons for absence in their service areas and the actions being taken to maximise attendance.
