1. **Pandemic Influenza**

Mr. P. Thomas was requested by Members to provide a Schedule of agreed Critical Services at the next Joint Resilience Committee meeting on October 9th 2009, along with a detailed assessment of each Council's preparedness for a possible pandemic.

The Chair expressed her concerns that the Taliesin Centre in Swansea was to be used as an Anti Viral Centre as it was considered to be unsuitable for this purpose.

As no report regarding this Exercise, which took place in April 2009, had been brought to today's meeting, Members requested an interim report be submitted prior to the next meeting in October 2009.

3. <u>Exercise Firefly (Flo Gas)</u>

Mr. P. Thomas stated at the meeting that a key issue arising from this exercise would be the potential closure of the adjacent motorway. Members were unhappy that such issues were not brought to their attention sooner.
