## 2. <u>GRANT OF DISPENSATIONS RENEWALS UNDER SECTION 81</u> (4) LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 2000

Members received an overview of Grant Dispensations, as detailed in the circulated report. The Head of Legal Services explained to Members that the Code of Conduct precludes Members from decision making and illustrated areas where dispensations may be given, for example, Employment Dispensations, Dispensations re School Governors, Standard Dispensation for School Re-organization and Dispensations for Third Sector Review as described in the report. Members considered applications received for the above mentioned dispensations, as detailed in the circulated report.

The Head of Legal Services previously reported to Standards Committee that the Welsh Government, the WLGA and the Public Services Ombudsman for Wales encourage local authorities to adopt Local Resolution Procedures with a view to resolving complaints of a breach of the Members' Code of Conduct locally.

The Head of Legal Services explained the process to Members and suggested that a procedure needed to be adopted to comply with guidance which had been issued. A proposed Local Resolution Procedure was attached to the circulated report, for Members' information and discussion.
