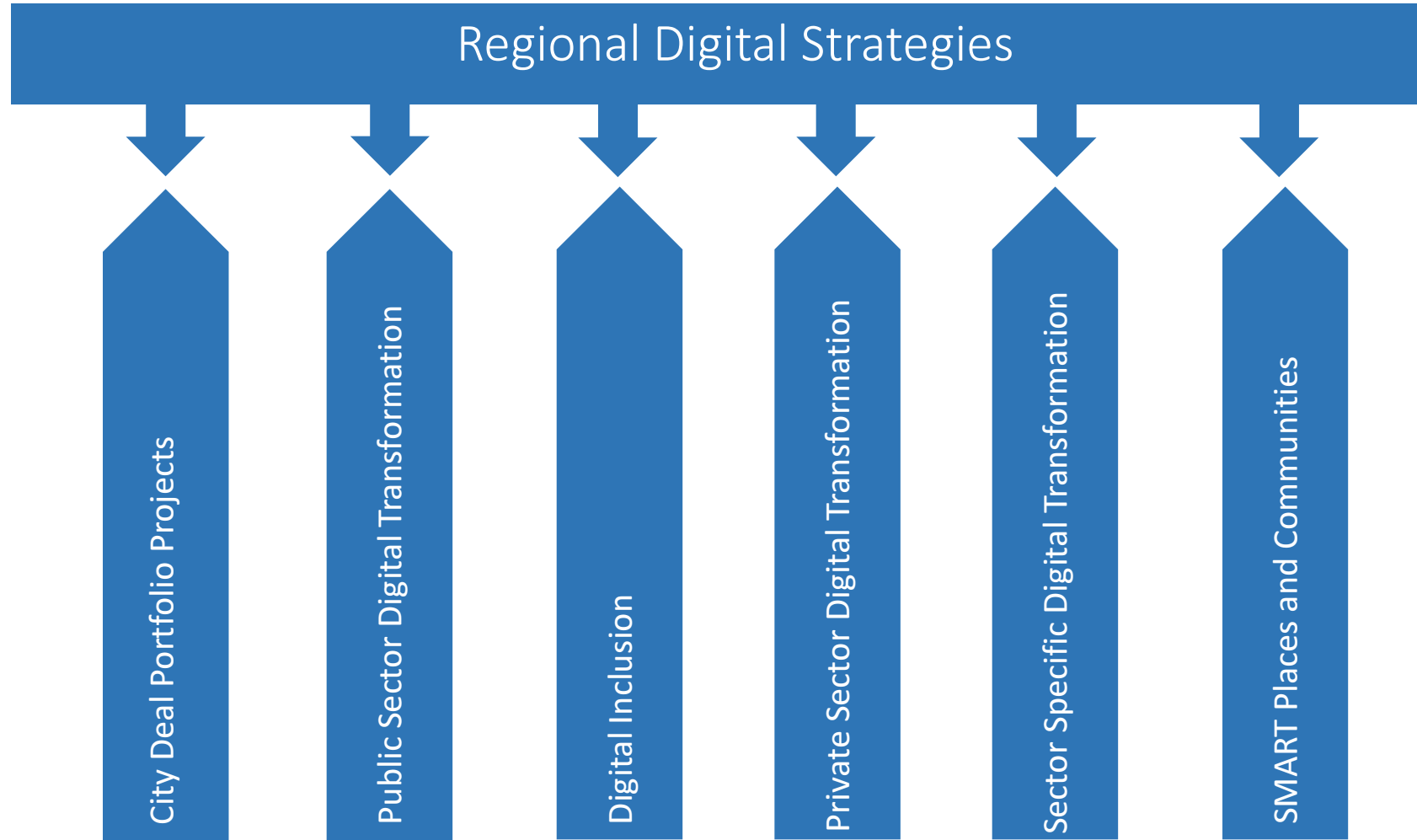

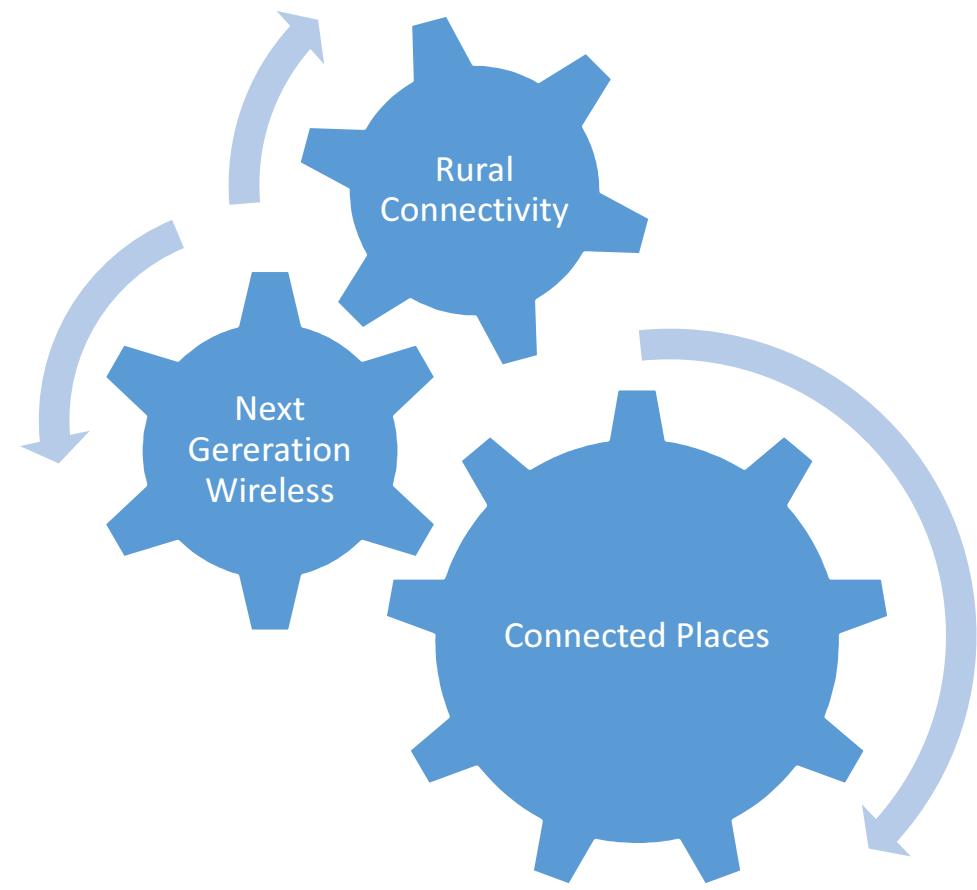

- Lack of awareness & understanding of alternatives

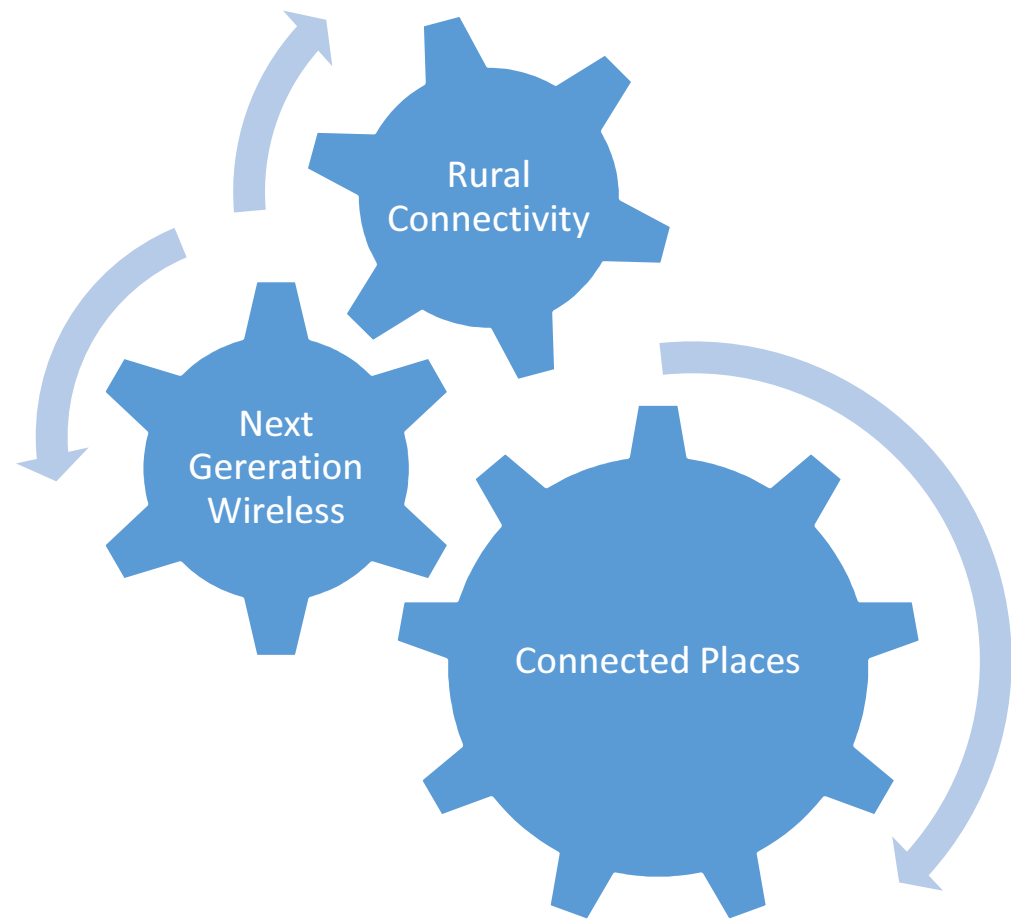

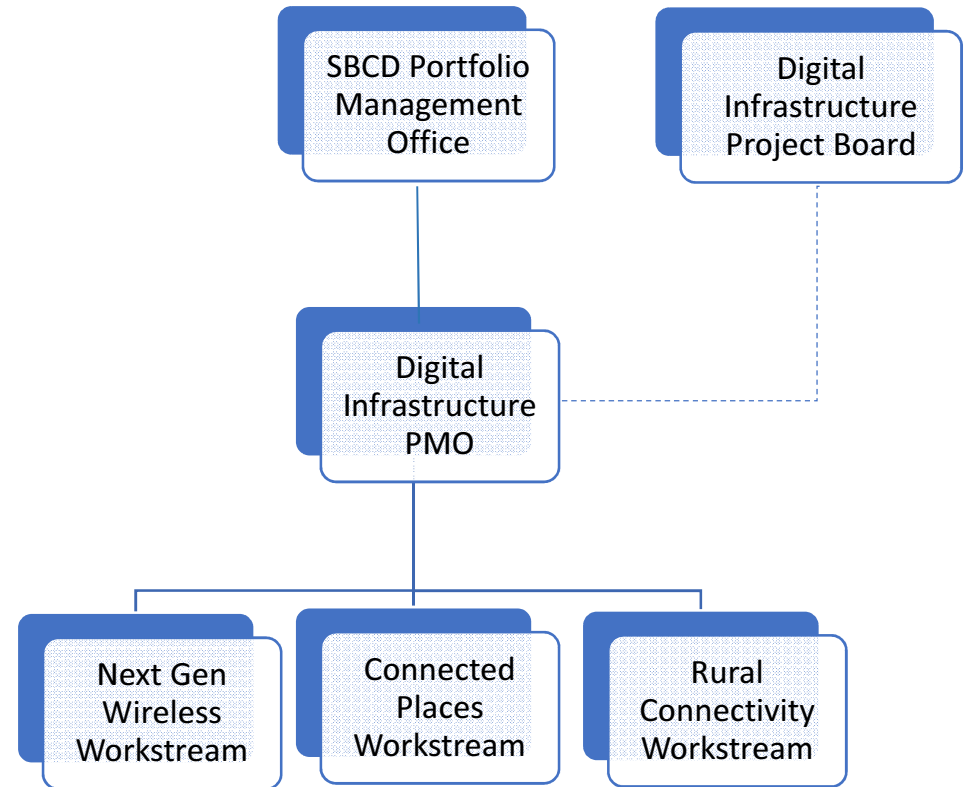
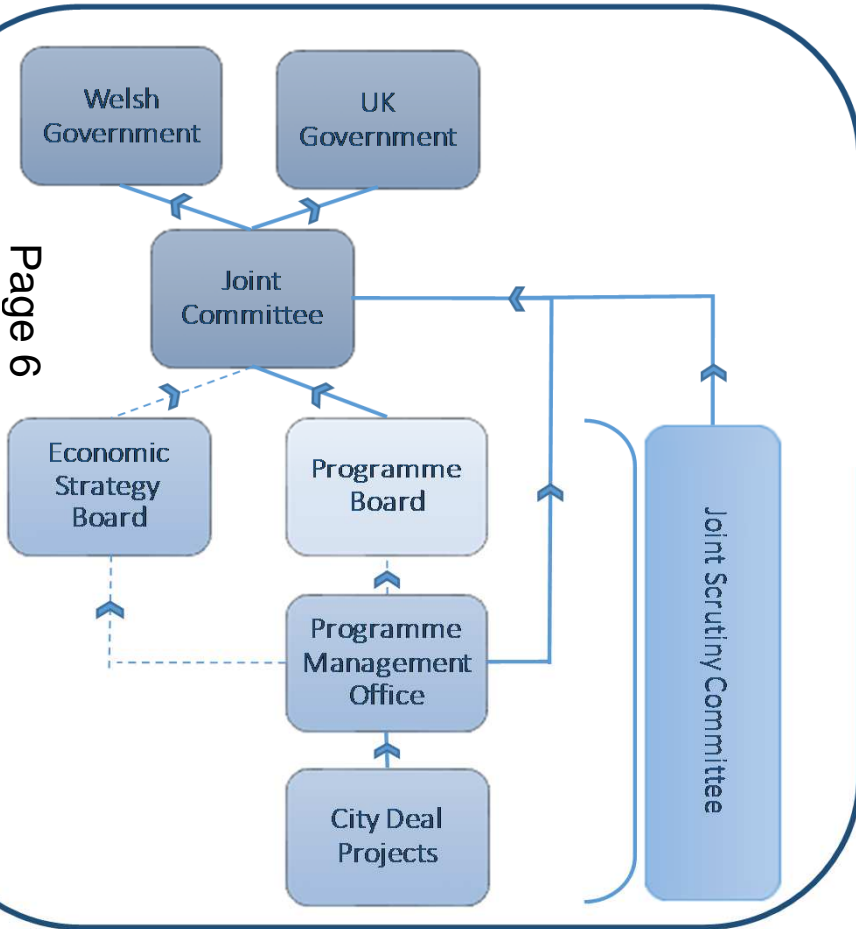
