**APPOINTMENT OF LA GOVERNOR REPRESENTATIVES AT
YSGOL GYNRADD GYMRAEG TREGELES**

Purpose of the Report

1. To appoint LA Governor Representatives to the new permanent governing body of Ysgol Gynradd Gymraeg Tregeles.

Background

Members will be aware that Ysgol Gynradd Gymraeg Tregeles opened as a starter school for part time nursery pupils in January 2023 with the first cohort of full time reception pupils expected to attend the new school from September 2023.

Members agreed in October, 2022, to the creation of an Instrument of Government, which created a permanent name for the school and an incorporation date when a permanent governing body would take office of 1st March, 2023. The temporary governing body will continue until this date in its current form when their role

and function will then come to an end. The current LA Governor Representatives on the temporary Governing Body are: Cllr. James Henton, Cllr. Andy Lodwig and Cllr. Alan Lockyer.

Members will be aware that LA Governor Representatives are appointed by the Council in priority order of i) Elected Members representing wards in the catchment area of the relevant school or pupil referral unit; ii) Other Elected Members of the LA and iii) Persons who, in the opinion of the Council, would contribute to the well-being of the school of pupil referral unit. As Briton Ferry West, Coedffranc Central, Coedffranc North, Coedffranc West, Dyffryn, Neath North are the Wards that are the catchment area for Ysgol Gynradd Gymraeg Tregales all elected Members in these areas have been asked whether they wish to be considered for appointment to the permanent governing body. Those that wish to be considered are (alphabetically):

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT - COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

1. The name of the school is:
Ysgol Gynradd Gymraeg Tregeles
2. The school is a community school.
3. The name of the governing body is:
The Governing Body of Ysgol Gynradd Gymraeg Tregeles
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) Four parent governors;
 - (b) Three local authority governors;
 - (c) One teacher governors;
 - (d) One staff governor;
 - (e) Four community governors;
 - (f) Headteacher (except at any time when he/she has given written notice to the clerk to the governing body that he/she chooses not to be a governor).
5. Total number of governors: Fourteen (except at any time when the Headteacher has given notice as above that he/she chooses not to be a governor, when the total number of governors will be thirteen).
6. This instrument of government comes into effect on 1st March, 2023.
7. This instrument was made by order of Neath Port Talbot Local Authority on 27th October, 2022.

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
