1. PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLE LICENSING

The Committee was asked to consider a request from Mr. D.W. Jones of "D.W. Executive Travel", to grant an exemption to display door signs and a rear back plate on a proposed private hire vehicle, namely an E Class Mercedes.

RESOLVED:

that an exemption to display door signs and a rear back plate on a proposed private hire vehicle, namely an E Class Mercedes, be approved on the condition that an exemption is granted on the basis of executive functions only and specifically excluding general private hire;

that delegated authority be given to the Head of Legal Services and Licensing Manager to grant a private hire vehicle licence to Mr Jones which will be exempt from displaying door signs and a back plate. Delegated authority will be subject to the following conditions being attached to the licence:

1. The door signs issued by the Council are not required to be displayed on the vehicle when the vehicle is being used for executive work;

- The back plate issued by the Council shall be secured to the inside of the boot at times when the vehicle is being used for executive work;
- If the vehicle is used for general private hire i.e. any work other than executive work, the door signs and back plate shall be secured to the locations specified in the Council's Taxi Licensing Policy.

2. **DRAFT STREET TRADING POLICY**

Members were asked to consider adopting the draft Street Trading Policy following the end of the consultation exercise, for implementation on 1 April, 2018.

It was noted that following the end of the consultation exercise, several amendments had been made to the draft policy as a result of representations from the Planning and Environmental Health Department.
