1. APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRPERSON

Agreed that Councillor C.Clement-Williams be appointed Chairperson for the meeting.

2. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

Decision:

That the Minutes of the previous meeting of Cabinet (Finance) Sub Committee held on 10 July, 2019, be approved.

3. MISCELLANEOUS GRANT FUND APPLICATIONS

Decisions:

- That grant assistance of £800 per annum to Scouts Wales, Glamorgan West Area, Cimla, towards the lease of land and Scouts buildings at Cimla Crescent Cimla, subject to review in line with rent reviews, be approved;
- 2. That grant assistance of £1660 per annum to Scouts Wales, Glamorgan West Area, Neath, towards lease of land and Scouts

buildings at Maes y Ffynon Close Neath, subject to review in line with rent reviews, be approved;
