## 1. <u>Licensing Section - Annual Report</u>

### 1.1 Purpose of report

To provide information to members in relation to Licensing matters for the period 2014 - 2015.

#### 1.2 Background

The Licensing Section is responsible for the administration and enforcement of licences and registrations that are issued for the following functions

- Hackney Carriage (taxis) and Private Hire
- Alcohol and Entertainment licences
- Gambling premises i.e. Bingo Halls, Betting Shops, Arcades
- Charitable Collections
- Boats and Boatmen
- Firework Storage
- Hairdressers
- Petroleum Storage
- Poisons
- Scrap Metal Dealers
- Sex Establishments and Sexual Entertainment Venues
- Stage Hypnotism
- Street Trading

An annual report for the period 2013 – 2014 was reported to members in August 2014, for comparison purposes, these figures are shown below in brackets.

## 1.3 Taxis and Private Hire Vehicle

The Licensing Section issue licences for hackney carriage vehicles and drivers and private hire vehicles, driver and operators. Licensing Officers carry out inspection of licensed drivers and vehicles during routine stop checks in addition to the pre arranged inspections that take place at Tregelles court.
