<u>Proposed Traffic Regulation Order</u> Cramic Way, Port Talbot

## **Purpose of Report**

1 To consider the objections received following the advertisement of the proposals as indicated in Appendix A.

## **Executive Summary**

- 2 Two objections were received in respect of the proposal.
- The report outlines the objections and the recommendation for the scheme

# **Background**

- Following the construction of the new Harbourside car park in association with the Port Talbot Parkway redevelopment it is proposed that a prohibition of waiting, loading and unloading at any time and a 1 hour limited waiting bay be implemented on Cramic Way and Oakwood Road.
- It was also noted that Cramic Way is an unlit road, therefore, a legal 30mph speed limit order is required.
- In December 2015 the proposals were advertised and at the same time a consultation exercise was undertaken to all properties directly affected by the scheme Appendix B.

7 Screening Assessment has been undertaken to assist the Council in discharging its Public Sector Equality Duty under the Equality Act 2010. After completing the assessment it has been determined that this function does not require an Equality Impact assessment.

Businesses affected by the proposals

- As part of the consultation exercise, a letter drop was undertaken to all businesses within the immediate vicinity of the proposals.

  During the consultation process two letters of objection were received;
- Business 1 stated that their burger van has traded on Cramic Way for the last 27 years and that the proposed traffic order would have a detrimental affect on their livelihood.

- Business 1currently has a trading licence to operate on the highway. The proposed traffic regulation order would prevent their burger van from parking on the highway meaning they would have to cease trading.
- 17 Business 2 stated that they strongly object to the proposed traffic order as it is directly outside of the business and is used by employees and customers to park their vehicles. It was also stated that the proposed traffic order would have an adverse effect on the business and requested an amendment to the scheme to include private or permit parking.
- Business 2 does not have enough off-street parking to accommodate all of their customers who currently park on the highway outside of the business. The proposed traffic regulation order would limit the waiting time to 1 hour for customers who sometimes require a longer stay so would have a detrimental effect on business.

#### Recommendation

- 19 It is recommended that:-
- The objections be upheld in part and that approval is given for the revised scheme to be advertised as indicated on the attached plans (Appendix C & Appendix D) and subject to there being no objections, for the Order to be implemented.
- 21 That the objectors to be informed accordingly.

## **Reasons for Proposed Decision**

- To allow Business 1 and 2 to continue to trade, whilst at the same time preventing indiscriminate parking in the interest of road safety within the immediate vicinity of the new Parkway Station.
- To legalise the 30mph speed limit for Police enforcement.
- The decision is proposed for implementation after a three day callin period.




