Taxi Licensing Policy (Amendments)

Purpose of the Report

1. To consider amendments to the Taxi Licensing Policy.

Executive Summary

- 2. This report is to consider amendments to the Taxi Licensing Policy.
- 3. Following the decision of a district judge to overturn the Council's decision to refuse a new Hackney Carriage Vehicle Licence, it is necessary to make some minor amendments to the renewal process contained within the Taxi Licensing Policy.
- 4. To ensure that all the procedures and process contained within the policy are unambiguous, some other minor amendments are also proposed.

Background

- 5. A report was presented to the Registration and Licensing Committee on the 26th September 2016, with details of an appeal against the Council's decision to refuse to grant a new hackney carriage vehicle licence.
- 6. As a result of the appeal hearing, it has become apparent that the renewal process for both vehicles and drivers as detailed in the Taxi Licensing Policy, requires some minor amendments.
- 7. The policy as a whole is also being continually reviewed. On occasion, the review identifies an area where the policy is not as clear as it could be. Some other minor amendments have therefore been made to the policy and need to be considered by the Registration and Licensing Committee.

Officer Report

- 8. It is proposed that the renewal process for both vehicles and drivers be amended to clarify how the Council will deal with an application that is received after the expiry of the licence. The amendments are shown bold and underlined at paragraph 2.9 and 3.10 in the policy attached at appendix 1
- 9. The other amendments to the policy are detailed below and the revised wording is shown bold and underlined in the policy attached at appendix 1.
- 10. Paragraph 2.3 The requirement that a DBS is required prior to every renewal does not account for those that are issued with annual licences.
- 11. Paragraph 2.3 and 2.9 Revision required to clarify that DBS certificates must be less than 3 months old on determination of the application, not on receipt of the application.
- 12. Paragraph 2.5 "Knowledge Test" renamed "Knowledge and Suitability Test"
- 13. Paragraph 2.6 and 2.9 Revision required to clarify that Medical Examinations must be less than 4 months old on determination of the application, not on receipt of the application.
