APPOINTMENT OF LA GOVERNOR
REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE TEMPORARY
GOVERNING BODY FOR THE NEW PRIMARY
SCHOOL YSGOL NEWYDD BRITON FERRY
(REPLACING BRYNHYFRYD, LLANSAWEL AND
YNYSMAERDY PRIMARY SCHOOLS).

Purpose of the Report

To appoint the third LA Governor Representative to the temporary governing body of the new primary school Ysgol Newydd Briton Ferry (replacing Brynhyfryd, Llansawel and Ynysmaerdy Primary Schools).

Background

1. Members will be aware that on 1st December, 2016, Cabinet agreed to establish a temporary governing body for a new school Ysgol Newydd Briton Ferry.

- Members will also recall that it was agreed that two LA Governor Representatives were appointed at this time, Councillor Hugh N. James and Councillor Colin Morgan, with the appointment of a third LA Governor Representative being deferred.
- Mr. Peter Nedin's name has been put forward to fill the vacant position of LA Governor Representative. Mr. Nedin is currently a serving LA Governor and Chair of Governors at Ynysmaerdy Primary School.
