School Terms Dates 2019/2020

Purpose of the Report

1. To obtain Children, Young People and Education Cabinet Board permission to consult on the proposed school term dates in respect of the 2019/2020 academic year.

Executive Summary

2. The Local Authority is responsible to determine school terms and holiday dates for community and maintained special schools and is required to consult on its proposals prior to determination.

Background

 To ensure harmonisation of school term dates across Wales, the Welsh Government have issued legislation which gives the Welsh Ministers power to direct authorities and the governing bodies of voluntary aided and foundation schools on the school term dates that they set.

- 4. Where agreement cannot be met, Welsh Ministers have the power to intervene and direct the Local Authority.
- 5. It is a requirement that the Authority inform the Welsh Ministers of term dates for the school year 2019/2020 by the final working day in August 2017.
- 6. The 2019/2020 school term dates proposed by Neath Port Talbot are those that have been agreed by the ERW Consortia and are the same as those proposed by the North Consortia and South Central Consortia.
- 7. Permission is sought to consult on the proposed 2019/2020 term dates which are attached as Appendix A.

Financial Impact

8. There are no financial impacts associated with this report.

9. A Screening Assessment has been undertaken to assist the Council in discharging its Public Sector Equality Duty under the Equality Act 2010.
