Matter for Decision

Ward Affected: Sandfields West

<u>Incorporation of Council Land into the Highway – Bae Baglan</u>

Purpose of Report

1 Members are requested to approve the dedication of various sections recently constructed/upgraded Council owned unadopted road, footway, parking bays and verge adjoining Ysgol Bae Baglan comprising part of Sirius Drive and adjoining Seaway Parade, Baglan, as highway.

Executive Summary

2 To formally dedicate as highway, a section of Council owned unadopted road, footway, parking bays and verge under Section 24(2) of the Highways Act 1980.

Background

- The Council own various sections of recently constructed/upgraded Council owned unadopted road, footway, parking bays and verge adjoining Ysgol Bae Baglan comprising part of Sirus Drive and adjoining Seaway Parade, Baglan, as approximately shown edged in black on the attached two plans (Appendix A).
- 4 Recent engineering works associated with the new Ysgol Bae Baglan have been constructed to a standard suitable for 'adoption'.
- 5 The proposal is to dedicate these areas of land as highway maintainable at public expense, under Section 24(2) of the Highways Act 1980 the power to construct new highways.

6 That part of the unadopted road, footway and verge shown cross hatched black is in unknown ownership and the intention is to adopt these areas as highway using S.228 of the Highways Act 1980.

Financial Impact

7 Future maintenance costs will be the responsibility of the Highway Authority which would be offset by its inclusion in the annual maintenance grant submission to Welsh Government.

- A Screening Assessment has been undertaken to assist the Council in discharging its Public Sector Equality Duty under the Equality Act 2010.
- 9 After completing the assessment it has been determined that this function does not require an Equality Impact Assessment.

Workforce Impacts

Legal Impacts

11 As a result of the dedication, the road, footway and verge become highway maintainable at public expense.

Risk Management

12 If not dedicated as highway maintainable at public expense ongoing maintenance liability would rest with Education, Leisure and Lifelong Learning.

Consultation

13 There is no requirement under the Constitution for external consultation of this item.

Recommendation(s)

It is recommended that:-

14 The various sections of unadopted road, footway, parking bays and verge become highway maintainable at public expense.

Reasons for Proposed Decision

15 To enable the road, footway, parking bays and verge to become highway maintainable at public expense.

Implementation of Decision

16 The decision is proposed for implementation after the three-day callin period.
