Public Space Protection Order, Aberavon Beach

Purpose of Report

1 To inform Members of changes to legislation regarding the control of dogs at Aberavon Beach.

Executive Summary

The Council previously set in place two Dog Control Orders at Aberavon Beach. As a result of new legislation these Orders have automatically become Public Space Protection Orders ("PSPO's").

Background

- Two existing Dog Control Orders for Aberavon Beach were made on 20th February 2013, and these in-turn superseded pre-existing byelaws for the seasonal control of dogs at Aberavon Beach.
- One of the orders made it an offence to take or allow a dog onto the beach in front of the promenade from May to September. The other order made it an offence not to keep a dog on a lead on the promenade from May to September.
- PSPO's were introduced by the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 and replaced a range of different orders including: Designated Public Place Order; Gating Orders; and Dog Control Orders.

- Orders in force on 20th October 2017 automatically became PSPO's. No action is therefore required to maintain in force the existing seasonal dog controls at Abervaon.
- 7 PSPO's have a duration of 3 years although at any point before expiry they can be extended for a further 3 years.
- All aspects of dog control remain unchanged compared to the previous Dog Control Order. The fixed penalty remains at £75, which reduces to £50 if paid within 10 days.
