## Background

3. The Licensing Section is responsible for the administration and enforcement of licences and registrations that are issued for the following functions:-

Alcohol and Entertainment licences
Gambling premises i.e. Bingo Halls, Betting Shops, Arcades

Licensing Officers carry out inspection of licensed drivers and vehicles during routine stop checks in addition to the pre-arranged inspections that take place at Tregelles court.
