Matter for Decision

Wards Affected: Neath North

Proposed Traffic Regulation Order at Water Street, Neath

Purpose of Report

1 To obtain Members' approval to advertise the Legal Order for Water Street, Neath, as indicated in Appendix A.

Executive Summary

The report outlines the proposed Order and the reason why the Orders are required.

Background

The Order is needed to assist with the proposed Neath Town Centre development. The proposal is to stop-up Fairfield Way and make Water Street two-way. The Order is required to prevent indiscriminate parking and provide a School Bus pick-up and drop-off facility outside the School Playground in the interest of highway safety and is subject to Welsh Government approval. The local School has been informally consulted over the drop-off and pick-up timings. The proposed scheme is indicated in appendix A.

Financial Impact

The work will be funded by NPTCBC Regeneration.

The decision is proposed for implementation after the three-day call-in period.


