Disability Audit - Update

Purpose of the Report

1. To update Committee on the progress made on carrying out a Disability Audit in relation to Members' facilities.

In accordance with Minute No 7 of the Democratic Services Committee held on 5 September 2018, a proposal has now been received from Proudlock Associates (sub-contractors for Shaw Trust) to carry out a disability audit of Members' areas of work at Port Talbot Civic Centre and Neath Civic Centre. The proposal is due to be considered at the first Disability Audit Group meeting on the 14th March 2019.
