Taxi Licensing Policy Amendment - Guidance on determining the suitability of applicants and licensees in the hackney and private hire trades

Purpose of the Report

 To consider replacing the existing "Fitness criteria for prospective and existing drivers and operators", with the "Guidance in determining the suitability of applicants and licensees in the hackney and private hire trades", following the completion of the consultation exercise.

Executive Summary

- 2. This report seeks to replace the existing fitness criteria for prospective and existing drivers and operators ("fitness criteria") contained at Appendix B of the Taxi Licensing Policy, with the guidance produced by the Institute of Licensing (IOL) 'Guidance in determining the suitability of applicants and licensees in the hackney and private hire trades' ("the guidance")
- 3. The guidance was issued for consultation with interested parties and two responses were received.

 Members are being asked to approve the adoption of the guidance which will replace the existing fitness criteria contained at Appendix B of the Taxi Licensing Policy.

Background

- 5. The Council has adopted a Taxi Licensing Policy containing the procedures, specifications and conditions which all prospective and existing licence holders need to be aware of.
- 6. Appendix B of the policy sets out the fitness criteria for prospective and existing drivers and operators. The fitness criteria was developed by the All Wales Licensing Expert Panel and was adopted widely by Local Authorities throughout Wales.
- 7. In April 2018, the IOL published a new document 'Guidance in determining the suitability of applicants and licensees in the hackney and private hire trades'

The guidance has been produced by the IOL in collaboration with the Local Government Association (LGA), National Association of Licensing and Enforcement Officers (NALEO) and Lawyers in Local Government (LLG) and has been the subject of widespread consultation nationally.

Officer Report

- 8. At the Registration and Licensing Committee in July 2019, members determined to issue the guidance for consultation with all licensed drivers, proprietors and operators.
- 9. The consultation exercise resulted in two responses and these are attached at appendix 1 and 2.
- 10. Following the end of the consultation period and taking into consideration the two representations received, it is considered that no changes are required to be made to the guidance. Members are therefore being asked to approve the adoption of the guidance, which will replace the existing fitness criteria contained at Appendix B of the Taxi Licensing Policy.
