

## **Appendix D.**

### **Background or 'Project Specifics' – Application MF052/T2**

To equip the street scene between Elba Crescent and Fabian Way (the A483) with an additional two 6 metre hinged aluminium public lighting columns with LED lanterns.

This bid has been developed to 'Enhance existing Council Services' by working closely with the NPTCBC's Public Lighting and Street Care Services. Works will include for service ducting, core cabling, pole isolators and reinstatement.

The columns will light (to a minimum of 3080 lumens) the gap in the field of illumination making it safer for residents and students to cross Fabian Way and have access to the bus stop.

The need for this initiative has come to the attention of the local Ward Member. The investment would improve safety, make the area brighter and less intimidating and allow both pedestrian and vehicular traffic to negotiate the junction.

The long term sustainable benefits associated with the project include making the immediate area more vibrant, better illuminated preventing trips and falls.

The scheme will be embraced within the current management and maintenance regime of the NPTCBC Public Lighting Team and their appointed Contractor ('Centre Great Ltd').

### **Recommendations**

The project is valued at £5,421.92, which has been arrived at by the Public Street Lighting Engineer and the master Bill of Quantities. The Applicant, Councillor Helen Ceri Clarke would wish to fund this project from her Members Fund allocation.

The project proposal is recommended for approval and financial support under the Members Community Fund.
