Background or 'Project Specifics' – Application MF058/T2

To develop a youth community artwork event at the 14th Neath (Cimla) Scout Group Headquarters, Cimla Crescent, Cimla, Neath.

This bid has been developed to 'Assist Voluntary Sector providers'.

The funding will be used to run two community days to involve young people in graffiti art. A professional graffiti artist will work with young people to create artwork on the steel storage freight container that is located within the grounds of the 14th Neath Scouts Headquarters.

This initiative will engage young people who may otherwise take to defacing public building with spray paint. It will be an opportunity to teach participants new skills and to give them purpose and a sense of ownership.

The need for this initiative has come to the attention of the local Ward Members as the Scout Group is permanently looking for ways to positively engage and grow its membership that has suffered during the pandemic.

The completed project will make the area more vibrant and attractive.

There are no financial implications for NPTCBC.

Recommendations

The project is valued at £1,000, which is the cost of preparing the container, the Design work, the aerosol paint and the PPE (facemasks, gloves and coveralls). The Applicants, Councillor John Warman and Councillor Adam McGrath would wish to fund this project to the tune of £500 each, with a contribution from her Members Fund allocation.

The project proposal is recommended for approval and financial support under the Members Community Fund.
