## Background or 'Project Specifics' - Application MF096/T2

To provide an electrical hook – up to a highway verge at Main Road, Cadoxton, to facilitate community events.

This bid has been developed to 'Enhance existing Council Services' and to prepare the area in readiness for the staging of future community activities.

The funding will be used to supply and install an electrical standpoint to allow safe supply of energy for Christmas festivities and the future planned development of the verge. Central Cadoxton has no green, flat open space that can be utilised for people to gather, mix, and enjoy each other's company and stage fundraising events. This installation will in the future be added to with benches, guard rails and raised planters to give the feel of a village green and a safe environment for children's games and the elderly.

The need for this initiative has come to the attention of the local Ward Member. The project proposal is to create a venue for the community to come together on a green open space. Earlier events and fetes staged on the tarmac surface at the car park in the 'Crown & Sceptre' and the church have had success but the verge is larger and can be more easily adapted to host more ambitious undertakings.

The scheme has no further financial implications for NPTCBC as there will be a metered supply for electricity connected to the 'Green Dragon' Public House. The Council's Public Lighting Dept. has been instrumental in arriving at these arrangements.

## Recommendations

The project is valued at £4,900.00 (net). The Applicant, Councillor Annette Wingrave would wish to fund this project from her Members Fund allocation.

The project proposal is recommended for approval and financial support under the Members Community Fund.
