Background or 'Project Specifics' – Application MF097/T2

To acquire two secure steel storage containers to assist Bryn and Cwmafan Events Group in their plight to stage existing and new village ventures.

This bid has been developed to 'Assist Voluntary Sector providers'.

The funding will be used to provide 8'x 8' steel lock – ups that are equipped with pedestrian doors, shelving and tool hooks.

The new acquisitions will help both the Cwmafan Community Orchard project in Parc Siencyn Powell and the Bryn Events Group at the Bryn Community Centre. Secure storage at the orchard project will assist in attracting new members as it will give both shelter from the elements and storage. There will be an opportunity for new members to the Group to make friends and socialise outdoors. The storage facility in Bryn will assist seasonal activity such as the Christmas and Easter displays.

The need for this initiative has come to the attention of the local Ward Member. The local area coordinator will use these new assets to further develop existing and new projects that, in time, will engage the wider community.

There are no financial implications for NPTCBC as the two units are of heavy gauge steel with no maintenance requirements.

Recommendations

The project is valued at £4,968.00, which is the full cost of purchase and delivery. The Applicant, Councillor Charlotte Galsworthy would wish to fund this project by allocating her remaining Members Fund allocation.

The project proposal is recommended for approval and financial support under the Members Community Fund.
