Community Activity:

During the past year I have supported my local constituents in what has been a very difficult year for many of them. Like all Council Members I have been involved in supporting our residents with issues including parking, fly-tipping, refuse collections, housing problems, flooding from the burst culvert within the ward, rubbish and drainage issues. I am also involved in representing local residents who have isues relating to the new Tai Tarian Housing Estate at Clos Castyn.

I have become involved in visiting and encouraging local businesses. I have even represented two of these businesses at a recent Planning Committee in the hope of encouraging more employment into the ward.

I regularly meet and keep contact with our PCSO's in the ward.

Initiatives and Special Activities:

During the year as a County Borough Councillor I have been involved in :

Working with a local church in the provision of warm space and a free breakfast club. I have also worked and helped the church with their Foodbank. I also now lead the worship at this church most Sunday's.

I have attended many performing arts events including school nativity plays. I have personally financed prizes for school arts competitions.

Prior to becoming a councillor in May 2022 I was heavily involved within the neighbourhood in bringing residents together for sing along's in the streets.
