
For the Quarter 1st April 2023 -30th June 2023 -95.41% was achieved. Quarter 1 performance remains above the target of 95%, based on 1059/1110 premises being classed as "Broadly Complaint" and achieving an equivalent of a 3 or 4 or 5 (out of 5) under the statutory National Food Hygiene Rating Scheme (Wales)




For the Quarter 1st April 2023 - 30th June 2023 - 22.18% was achieved. Quarter 1 performance is on Target - being at 22%. Actual figures were 61 out of 275 high risk businesses which were inspected.






For the Quarter 1st April 2023 -30th June 2023 -88.70% was achieved .This figure is impressive, however it does not take into account the alleged breaches that are to be confirmed. The department has had an influx of underage sales complaints since January, 11 in the period under scrutiny, but not recorded as breaches until they are substantiated, the same can be said for illicit tobacco and counterfeit products. This Performance Measure is likely to be revised in the new financial year in a move to standardise reporting across Wales and to reflect the work that Trading Standards carries out across the country.
