Level 2 Window of tolerance and Zones of Regulation (ZOR) training will be offered once in the Autumn term this year. If schools require whole school adds training, they can email J.marshman@npt.gov.uk to discuss this further.

New ZOR Training offer this year:

Naomi Erasmus (Educational Psychologist) and James Marsham (Occupational Therapist) will run a Zones of Regulation community of practice (CoP) to support you with your implementation of the Zones of Regulation curriculum designed to foster self-regulation through sensory supports, calming techniques and thinking strategies.

A community of practice (CoP) is a group of people who share a common concern, a set of problems, or an interest in a topic and who come together to fulfil both individual and group goals. Communities of practice often focus on sharing best practices and creating new knowledge to advance a domain of professional practice.

Interaction on an ongoing basis is an important part of this.

In the Autumn term we will be focusing on delivery of lessons one to six. In the Spring term we will be focusing on delivery of lessons seven to twelve. In the Summer term we will be focusing on delivery of lessons thirteen to eighteen. The sessions will be 9am-10:30am with a Primary focus and 10:30am-12 noon will be a Secondary focus.

Please note all staff (regardless of the age you teach) are welcome to both sessions as you may need to adjust or change the lesson and its goals based on the specific needs of the learners in your environment i.e., younger or older differentiation depending on the developmental level of the pupils that you teach. **This training is limited to 1 place per school (20 participants maximum).**

N.B You must have accessed the Level 1 and Level 2 Window of Tolerance and Zones of Regulation training to be part of the Zones of Regulation community of practice (CoP).
